What Wallasey Labour Is Fighting For:

✓ Saving Our On-Street Parking

We have made the views of residents clear to Liverpool City Region – we need a plan to preserve on-street parking and disabled bays.

✓ Getting Accurate Information To You

You have been led to believe this is a council proposal, but it isn't. It comes from Liverpool City Region and the Department for Transport are responsible for the proposed route. The proposals were **ALWAYS** going to be changed based on the views of local residents, and you will get a final say on the revised proposals. It also isn't just a cycle lane. It's also about walking and mobility. **Your local Councillors should have told you this.**

✓ Ensuring You Have Your Say

After talking with Liverpool City Region officials, the proposals will be altered and brought back to you for comment before the end of the year. **Parking will be saved and the proposed route will be changed to minimise potential impact on you**, after Cllr Tom Usher, candidate for Wallasey Ward made a representation on behalf of residents.

✓ Access For All

While we've fought for the proposals to protect on-street parking and minimise inconvenience for drivers, **there are benefits to this scheme we don't want Wallasey to miss out on.** The mobility lane will bring **access**, opportunities and **safer, healthier** streets for older and younger people who can't get a license, those with disabilities, and motorists who also cycle and walk.
